Disneyland Paris is the perfect playground for the whole family and especially for young children. Here, all their dreams come true! Who hasn't imagined one day of flying over the rooftops of London in boats, or meeting Disney characters to take unforgettable photos or of dancing to your favourite tracks?

Many attractions and a host of activities await young children and their parents. So for a perfect trip, etched forever in your memories and on your photos, follow the guide.









DISNEYLAND PARK[®]

Majestic and enchanting, the *Sleeping Beauty Castle* takes pride of place at the entrance to Fantasyland promising what's to come: it's going to be an impressive journey! While the entire park is full of dozens of attractions to enjoy with your children, most of those which are suitable for babies and young children are located in the colourful fairy-tale world of Fantasyland.



To make a gentle start, climb on board the **Casey Jr. – le Petit Train du Cirque** or the **Pays des Contes de Fées** if you prefer water rides. The ride through the valleys and hills of Storybook Land reveals scenes from Disney films reproduced in miniature. Will you recognise Rapunzel's high tower or the fountain in the centre of Sleeping Beauty's village? Stay attentive to take everything in!

Continue the journey on an elephant's back with **Dumbo the Flying Elephant**, or perched on a magnificent wooden horse in **Le Carrousel de Lancelot**. Young parents not afraid of feeling dizzy will accompany their children to a Wonderland on board **Mad Hatter's Tea Cups**. Have you recovered from the excitement? Enter **Alice's Curious Labyrinth** and then try to find your way back out keeping your cool.



Did you know that at Disneyland Paris there's lots of things to see and do inspired by the rest of the world?

Set off to **Peter Pan's Flight** and take a seat in a small flying boat over the rooftops of London, Big Ben and Tower Bridge under starry skies.

As soon as you've landed, then you're off again for a trip into space with **Orbitron**, **Machines Volantes** where a fleet of space shuttles transports guests of all ages into a timeless future. For an overview, we highly recommend you settle your entire family aboard the **Disneyland Railroad**. This steam train offers a trip around the park to explore the Grand Canyon.



For those in a hurry and who are impatient, you can also travel the whole world in just a few minutes thanks to the world's most famous musical cruise: "*it's a small world*".



WALT DISNEY STUDIOS PARK[®]

Musl-see altractions"

Toddlers are welcomed by Aladdin's Genie to ride the blue dream on Les Tapis Volants - Flying Carpets over Agrabah. Next, they have a driving lesson alongside Lightning McQueen on Cars Quatre Roues Rallye and may even shrink to the size of Rémy to embark on a 4D adventure that whets the appetite in Ratatouille: The Adventure.

You can't miss Toy Story Playland! A giant Buzz Lightyear greets you at the entrance, children will love to embark on family adventures in the world of Disney•Pixar's Toy Story. *Slinky Dog Zigzag Spin*, is a wacky attraction that takes the whole family for a ride on the back of Slinky Dog, as he embarks on some loopy laps trying to catch his tail around a dog bowl filled with rubber bones . On leaving the attraction, another recurring character of the saga awaits us for an unforgettable photo shoot: Rex the Tyrannosaur.





Stitch Live

The Intergalactic Federation calls on all guests. Your mission: Help Lilo find Stitch who has escaped by using Captain Gantu's shuttle. A satellite link is therefore established to communicate with the famous and unpredictable extra-terrestrial.

TO SEE STARS SHINE IN THEIR EYES

Take your children to see Mickey in person on the stage of his **Meet Mickey Mouse** theatre. See the beautiful Elsa in her ice palace at **Animation Celebration**. These are all opportunities to see your favourite heroes and capture magical moments.

Mickey's friends' **Selfie Spots** are also great opportunities to meet the iconic characters of Disneyland Paris and have an immersive photo experience in beautiful, especially adapted sets. Meetings which will thrill young and old alike where you can take selfies to your heart's delight.

<u>As a bonus</u>:

In addition to the selfie spots, Mickey and his friends make many surprise appearances in the two parks to give all guests a memorable experience. So get your cameras ready and stay on the lookout!

WHERE TO EAT ?

What you need to know:

View the menus of all the restaurants in the park and book your table up to two months in advance via the official Disneyland Paris mobile app (available on the App Store and Google Play).

While all the restaurants of the park offer a children's menu, Disneyland Paris

goes further and offers its young guests the best nutritional choices under

the "Disney Check" label. A quick and simple way to identify nutritional

benefits for meals for children aged from 3 to 11 and the assurance of

eating at least two portions of fruit and vegetables.

<u>The plus point</u>: Is it your child's birthday?

Become their superhero by making this a magical and unforgettable day! Book a birthday cake to share, available in all Disneyland Paris restaurants. You can do so at your Disney Hotel reception but also by phone up to two months before your arrival date.

How do I know which attraction is suitable for my child?

Feel free to visit the Disneyland Paris website or use the mobile app. The attractions can be sorted using different filters such as age or height.

What is the best season to come to the park?

All of them are good for experiencing unforgettable moments all year round, thanks in particular to the covered attractions in case of bad weather.

A tip for young parents?

Young children love running around everywhere and it may be tempting to let go of mum or dad's hand to run closer to Baloo, passing nearby. A pushchair is therefore an essential item for keeping them safe and especially for creating quiet moments. <u>The plus point</u>: For all those parents who don't want to have worry about bringing a pushchair with them, the Disney Parks rent them out per day. Find them at Town Square Terrace in Disneyland Park or Studios Services at Walt Disney Studios Park.

Please note that you will not be able to go from one park to another with the same pushchair (unless you leave a deposit), but please don't worry, you'll be able to swap it for another one at no extra charge.



There is so much to see along the line while waiting your turn that you will be busy answering their questions and the time will rush by. <u>The plus point</u>: You can download the Disneyland Paris app with the real-time waiting times for each attraction.

Are there facilities for children aged 0 to 7 in my Disney Hotel?

Of course all the Parks' hotels have swimming pools suitable for children, full baby equipment (bath, foldable bed, etc.) and even a bedroom babysitting service (in some Disney Hotels for an extra charge) for parents who want to have a romantic dinner.

The plus point: children under the age of 3 are Disneyland Paris guests as they go free, including in the hotels!

Where can I change my baby?

Changing tables can be found in most toilets and in all the restaurants of the resort as well as in Disney Village. But there is also a Baby Corner in each park: near the Plaza Gardens Restaurant in Disneyland Park and behind Studios Services at Walt Disney Studios Park. A place where you can be quiet and take a break with your children. Practical info: for minor bumps and scrapes, first-aid posts are located just next to them.

Bonus: For forgotten items or little accidents, nappies and food jars are also available for sale.

The really good idea '

For those attractions too big for young children, please note that if you are two adults with (a) child(ren) and you want to go on a big thrill ride, remember the *Rider Switch*. This allows you to take turns without having to queue twice. Just tell the Cast Members before boarding the attraction!

ONE LAST TIP ?

Go at your child's pace. There's so much to see! Every character, every piece of scenery, all the entertainment is a discovery for them, so allow enough time to see everything.

Take advantage of the free shuttle service between the theme parks and your hotel to take a "nap" break with perhaps the surprise of meeting characters in the corridors!
